

Meet the Team - Abdi



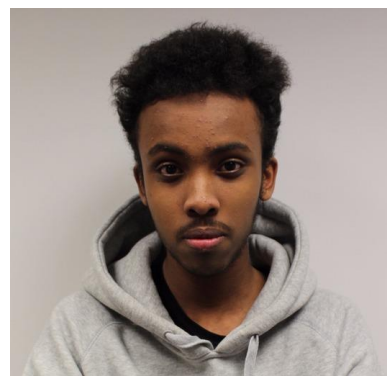
