Here at Ashley Community Housing we're excited to announce that 100 of our learners will be using 24+ loans to pay for their learning at a college course, or training provider throughout February until July. 24+ loans allow our learners and tenants to pursue their dreams, by enrolling into a course that can provide them with qualifications enhancing their progression and growth within education and employment.

Many of our learners and tenants at Ashley Community Housing have been volunteer teaching assistants, after applying for 24+ loans they will be able to enrol on a teaching assistant trainee course to become a paid teaching assistant. By enrolling learners onto different courses allows not only economical change, but also provides schools to develop their work force which is currently vital due to the shortage of teachers.

A quote from one of our learners enrolling on a teaching assistant course due to applying for 24+ loans was, "I've always wanted to do this course for years, but never had the opportunity". This quote itself highlights the significance 24+ loans has in allowing better opportunities for learners and tenants for the future.
