The article was a fantastic opportunity for Fuad to delve into the complex topic of integration and how this relates to the resettlement of refugees in the UK. The 'Behind the Headlines' feature found Fuad elaborating on his background as a former refugee and how this has shaped the development of the resettlement service we provide at ACH:

"I was fortunate enough to be able to establish myself and work my way towards a university education which allowed me to access a number of job opportunities... There were many other refugees in 1998 that were sadly not able to access the most basic support, language and employability training. 17 years later, I want to ensure that every refugee resettling in the UK has adequate support and training which will allow them to reach sustainable independence."

Fuad went on to discuss ACH's housing, support and training provisions in more detail, demonstrating how they will work towards supporting the government's commitment to resettle 20,000 refugees by 2020.

"The efficiency of our resettlement service only adds to the long-term benefits for our tenants who, once settled in housing, can focus on building skills and moving towards permanent employment."
