

# Come with us on the journey of a lifetime

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Our recently introduced course 'Computer Skills for work and life' has proved really popular with our community. Due to demand we're starting a second course on 7th December 2016, running on Wednesday afternoons.

This course fits in well with the new training approach at Himilo Training. Instead of running traditional ESOL classes we are inviting our clients on a learning journey to develop their English language whilst learning other skills. During our E1 Computer course students will start with learning how to switch a computer on and off, moving on to Health and Safety and Online Security, after which we look at Email communication and working with word documents. At the end of the course the student should be able to use the computer as a tool to support their English learning skills, e.g. using a thesaurus when writing on the computer to improve their texts or undertaking an internet search, which can help them with travel planning or job search. Once students feel confident about using those tools they can more easily progress to higher level courses, like the Level 1 Introduction to Health, Social Care and Children and Young People's Settings course which started earlier this month.
